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## How to knit an I-Cord

A knitted tube (I-Cord) can be worked easily without a knitting spool.  
You only need 2 double-pointed needles.



Cast on 4 stitches.

Slip them to the right end of the needle. Make sure that the stitches are close together.



Knit the stitches, even though the working thread is on the left side of the stitches.

Pull the thread tight.

Slip the 4 stitches to the right end of the needle and knit them again, pulling the thread tight.



Continue like that: knit 4 stitches, slip them to the right end of the needle, knit them again.

To finish the I-Cord, knit all stitches together. Break the yarn and pull it through the remaining loop.
