Knitting chevrons

Chevrons are created by a specific distance between increases and decreases.



In the example, there are 5 knit stitches between the increases and the decreases. With a wider distance you'll get bigger chevrons. With a smaller distance, the chevrons become narrower and more pointed.

yarn over



k2tog = knit 2 stitches together



sl 1 k1 pssso = slip 1 stitch, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over the knit one



sl 1 k2tog pssso = slip 1 stitch, knit 2 stitches together, pass slipped stitch over k2tog
