Chair leg covers - Chair socks

Chair socks are a useful alternative to felt glides for the chairs and look droll as well. You need two leftover sock yarns and a crochet hook (Size 4.5 to 5.0 mm / UK size 7 to 6 / US size 7 to 8). The pattern is written in US terms (UK terms in brackets). Two strands of yarn are held together to crochet the socks.



Make a chain of 5 and join to work in the round.

1. Round: Make 8 single crochets (UK: double crochets) into the chain ring.
2. Round: Make 2 single crochets (UK: dc) into each single crochet (dc) = 16 stitches.
3. Round: *1 sc (dc) into first sc (dc), 2 sc (dc) into second sc (dc)*, repeat from * to *. = 24 stitches. The sole is finished.



Work 3 to 5 rounds of double crochet (UK: treble) without further increases until you have reached the desired length of your chair sock.

Attention: In the first round of dc (tr), you can adjust the circumference: either skip stitches as necessary, or work 2 stitches into one. If in doubt, decide for a narrower circumference.



Finish with one round *1 sc (dc), ch 5* for a loopy edging.
